Terms of reference for the Study

- I. Review the current status of the EIC and assess its potential to meet the demands of emerging global trade scenario in the context of WTO/Multilateral and Bilateral agreements.
- II. Assess the effectiveness of organization to serve its clients and suggested measures for its restructuring.
- III. Review/assess the volume of work of EIC at various centers of trade and industry and suggest an integrated and optimum network of offices for 20 years period keeping in view the prospective growth and need of economizing administrative and establishment expenditure of EIC in the short term and long term
- IV. Review the present manpower capabilities and to recommend needs for capacity building, acquisition of new manpower, and possibilities of outsourcing.
- V. Identify various locations of EIC in order to optimize the manpower deployment so as to plan and execute infrastructural development projects in economical and efficient manner.
- VI. Review the user charges keeping in view the services rendered by EIC to clients/ exporters/ institutions keeping in view its costs and utility.
